

MEXICO MISSION TRIP

Children's Cup – www.childrencup.org

DESTINATION: Aguascalientes, Mexico

Children's Cup operates several CarePoints (read more about what these are on their website at www.childrencup.org) in the city of Aguascalientes, Mexico. This city houses their Villas de Loma (402), Progreso (403), Palomino (404), and Miradores (405) communities. It is a beautiful city whose architecture is influenced by its Spanish heritage. In the downtown area, the historic district is lined with cobblestone streets and historic buildings more than a century old. There are beautiful rolling hills and rich farm land on the cities edge. Aguascalientes is a strategic and influential city with many government officials and leaders of industry making their residence there. Due to its centralized location, it is strategic for businesses and, unfortunately, also for illegal trading. Although prosperous in many ways, Aguascalientes has one of the highest suicide rates in Mexico. The children in the poorest communities are suffering from severe malnutrition, which has caused a number of significant health issues and concerns.
