Safety Concerns

Let's be diligent in maintaining the safety of our children!



* Infants and toddlers should never be left in a car while the parent walks an older child into or out of the building. Waking a sleeping child is a small sacrifice to keep them from harm. Leaving a young child in a car unattended is also illegal, and subject to a \$250 fine.

* Do not leave your car parked in a fire lane - fire lanes are denoted by the yellow paint on the curb. There can be a sizable fine should the fire marshal observe your car parked in one of these areas.



* Do not allow preschoolers and kindergarten children to run to the car without you. They may run across the parking lot without looking. Please be sure that your children do not exit the building until you do.
